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DETAILED ITINERARY

This tour is ideal for anyone on a tight schedule that would love to see as much of the Cape Peninsula's beauty in the shortest amount of time available.

At 8am you will be collected at your hotel where after we will drive along the coastline through Greenpoint, Seapoint promenade, Camps bay, the Twelve Apostles through Hout Bay and onto Chapmans peak, one of the worlds most scenic drives. We will then make our way through Noordhoek and arrive at Boulders beach to see and learn about the super-cute penguins before making our way to Cape Point Nature Reserve, the Southwestern most point of Africa where we should see some wild buck, ostriches, dassies and maybe even an elusive caracal. We will then walk up the hill to the lighthouse (or ride the funicular-guests expense) to take in the breathtaking 360 degree panoramic views.

Back on the road we will make our way to Simonstown to hear about the only dog,

"Just Nuisance" to be inducted into the navy as an official "Able-seamen" before driving through Fish Hoek, stopping at Kalk bay (voted the world's "hippest" town by Forbes Magazine), then Muizenberg for a few snapshots of the iconic colourful beach huts.

We will then make our way to Stellenbosch, South Africa' second oldest town, renowned for producing internationally acclaimed award-winning wines and a thriving University culture. Here we can explore the quaint boutiques, possibly a museum before making our way to Delaire Graff estate where after we will take a leisurely drive home through the vineyards.

This tour moves at a slightly faster pace than the standard Cape Peninsula tour. Should we cover all the beautiful landmarks with some time to spare, we may even visit a second wine estate.



BASIC ITINERARY

8:00am collection at hotel.

Drive along through Greenpoint, Seapoint, Camps bay, Hout bay, Chapmans peak, Noordhoek arriving at Cape Point Nature Reserve.

Visit Boulders beach to see the penguin colony.

Visit Cape Point, the Southwestern most point of Africa. Cape Point Lighthouse, take a few snapshots (R90 funicular ride up or walk at no charge)

Quick stop at Simonstown, drive through Fish Hoek, stop at Kalk bay and Muizenberg beach.

Visit the town of Stellenbosch before stopping for a wine tasting at Delaire Estate.

WHAT TO WEAR

Comfortable clothing, hat, sunscreen (always apply 30 minutes prior to entering the sun), walking shoes, light jacket.

COLLECTION/DROP-OFF

Collection can be accommodated within 10km of the CBD or minor fee may apply. Alternative collection can be arranged within the CBD

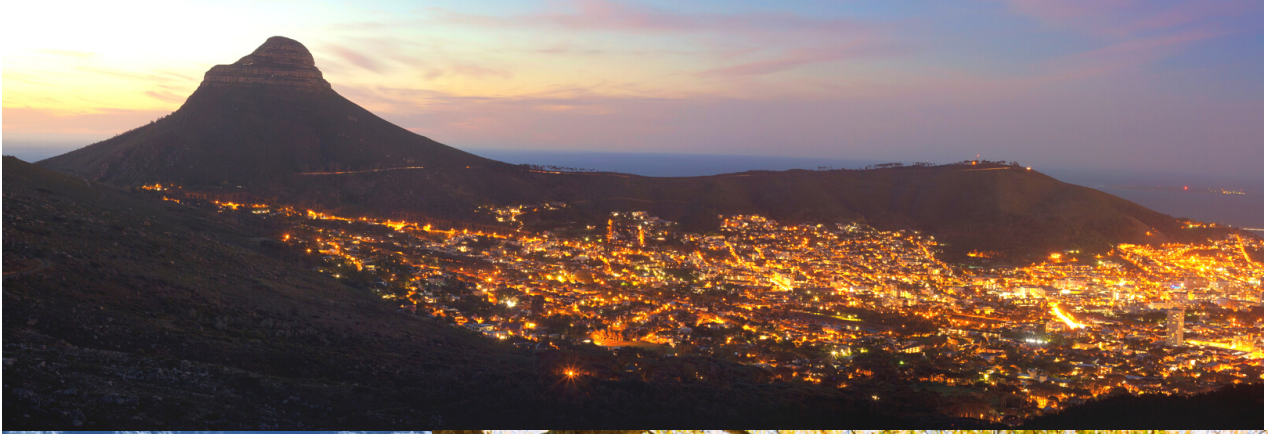
