DETAILED

ITINERARY

You will be collected at your hotel at 8h30 where after we will drive to Table Mountain cableway, ascend the cable car to enjoy the magnificent views below. You can then explore and take a few pics of the beautiful fauna and flora. We will then descend the mountain, drive past Signal Hill to watch the paragliders confidently run off the hill, before driving to the CBD to explore on foot, visiting Greenmarket square, the Company Gardens, The Slave Lodge and City hall, where Mandela gave his iconic speech when he was released from prison. Next is a visit to Cape Castle to hear how this fortress came to be, before we make our way

to the Bo Kaap, a colourful neighbourhood inhabited by descendants of the first Malay slaves. We will then drive to the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront, where you can do a bout of shopping or visit the Two Oceans Aquarium.

We will then take a drive to Groot Constantia, South Africa's first wine estate renown for producing Napoleon's favourite wines. To wind down we will take a drive past Camps bay and stop for a "sundowner" at one of the suburb's trendy beachside Cafe's, where after you will be taken back to the comfort of your hotel.
