













DETAILED ITINERARY

Enjoy a day tour of the Cape Wine lands, experience three wine estates and visit the picturesque regions of Stellenbosch, Franschoek and Paarl.

You will be picked up at 9am, then travel to Stellenbosch, South Africa's second oldest town renowned for its thriving wine industry and university culture. We can casually stroll through its Oak tree lined streets, admire the beautifully restored architecture, pop into a museum, browse a few boutiques and maybe stop for a quick cup of coffee at one of the street side cafés. Next we will drive to the 'multiple award winning' Delaire Estate for a wine tasting where after we will make our way to Franschoek(French corner) to the Huguenot museum to learn about the French settlers who fled religious persecution, yet were fortunate enough to be allowed to settle in this lovely region that coincidentally also looks like parts of France.

We can then explore the town on foot, before stopping at The Country Grand to enjoy lunch complimented by the most breath-taking 'oil painting-like" views of the wine lands. Next we will stop for a quick Instagram moment outside the prison where Mandela was kept. Our journey will take us to Babylonstoren, another stunning, well-manicured estate, boasting gardens straight out of a Fairy tale to enjoy your third tasting before moving onto Fairview for a final cheese and wine pairing. Our last stop will be at the Spice Route, voted "Best wine farm experience in the Cape" (by KFM radio) as it has various offerings to tantalize the taste buds. Here gin, beer, wine or chocolate can be tasted. As our tour draws to a close we will take a slow cruise through the vineyards, onto the freeway, back to the comfort of your hotel. As this is a private tour, minor changes can be accommodated for..just ask..
